Flu Vaccination Record

Copies of Flu Vaccination records, for all horses competing *must* be sent to the Entries Secretary with the entry, these must include the diagram of the horse. Please mark on the copies if the vaccinations have been restarted at any time, and that you have checked vaccination dates to ensure that they are correct. **Passports must be available for checking on the day of the competition**

Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not must wear a hard hat with the harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked BS/EN 1384, PASO15 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed.

All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

Prize winners will be expected to attend the prize giving mounted and correctly dressed.

The organisers of this competition have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everybody at the event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and to obey instructions by stewards. All heights of fences quoted are for the first round only- they will be raised in the 2nd Round. Classes 3,4,5,7 and 8 are all 2 round competitions with a jump off if leading teams are equal after 2 rounds

Class 1

Style Jumping : Senior Teams and individuals Fences not exc 85cms
Horse/ponies to have no more than 10 BE points or £175

Class 2

Style Jumping : Junior Teams and individuals Fences not exc 85cms
Eligibility as class 2

Class 3 Intermediate Show Jumping: Junior teams and individuals Fences not exc 95cms
Horses/ponies not to have won more than £175

Class 4

Intermediate Show Jumping :Senior teams and individuals Fences not exc 95cms
Eligibility as Class 6

Class 5

Senior Team and Individuals Open Show Jumping:Fences not exc 1.10m
Horses not to have won more than £600

Two Phase Individual open to all BRC members First phase 60cms to 80cms Entry fee £8 – entry to be made on enclosed entry form. Enclose SAE for times

Class 7

11am start

Junior Team and Individual Novice Show Jumping Fences not exc 80cms
Horse/ ponies to have no BS money other than notional money gained in 70cm or 80cm classes at BS Intro Shows

Class 8

Senior Team and Individual Novice Show Jumping Fences not exc 80cms
Eligibility as Class 6

Entry Fees

- Classes 1 and 2 £40 per team, £10 per Individual
- Classes 4,5,6,7 and 8.£70 per team £17.50 per individual
