GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR SWRC COMPETITIONS

Run under BRC Rules 2010 which can be found on SWRC website

- Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM 95, SNZ3838 1998. Skull cap hats must be worn with a silk.
- Long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such way as not to hang lower than the shoulder line.
- Jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are not permitted.
- A horse or pony may compete from 1 January in the year that it becomes 5 years old.
- Horses/ponies may be ridden once only in each class.
- Only competitors may work in their horses/ponies prior to a class or phase.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, judge: times or any other published information. Refund of entry fees less £2 will be made only on production of a vet's or doctor's certificate, except in the event of cancellation where all fees will be refunded less 15%.
- Unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS accident & emergency callou
- **Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.**

The South Wilts Riding Club organisers of the competitions, and the land owners, accept NO LIABILITY for damage or injury to persons, animals or property, however caused. All entrants and their supporters must be aware that liability for accidents, however caused, may fall on them.
