

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

The competitions will be run under British Riding Club rules for 2016

Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hats marked PAS 015 and prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk.

Long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such a way as not to hang lower than the shoulder line.

Gloves are compulsory for dressage, and a body protector is recommended for show jumping.

A horse or pony may compete from 1 Jan in the year that it becomes 4 years old.

Horses with BD points are not eligible to enter class 5 (prelim only).

Only competitors may work in their Horse/pony prior to a class or phase

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, times or any other published information. In the event of cancellation all fees will be refunded less 15%

Unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency callout

Dogs are not allowed at the venue

The South Wilts Riding Club organisers of the competition, and the landowners, accept NO LIABILITY for damage or injury to persons, animals or property, however caused. All entrants and their supporters must be aware that liability for accidents, however caused, may fall on them.

Times will be issued for all classes. If you miss your allocated time we will try to fit you in at the end of the class but only if entries allow.

Entries will be limited so we can get all the classes into daylight hours and warm up will be limited to 6 in the arena
