**Best Riding club horse/pony – May be asked to jump a small jump.

***ROR – Any blemishes from racing will be ignored

**** Veterans - Horse or pony over 15 years. Age to be displayed on armband

***** Best Cob – Horse or Pony, Traditional or Trimmed.

VENUE DETAILS

Entry **MUST NOT** be made via the turning within the village of Tollard Royal as the road is too steep and narrow to accommodate transport for horses.

The roads to Tollard are narrow and scouts will be there directing traffic and ensuring there is no congestion due to lorries meeting.



Warm up will be on grass. Showjumping will be in the indoor arena on a surface. In-hand and Ridden showing classes will be held in two outdoor grass arenas

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hats marked PAS 015 and prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk.

Long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such a way as not to hang lower than the shoulder line.

A body protector is recommended for show jumping.

A horse or pony may compete from 1 Jan in the year that it becomes 4 years old (ridden).

Only competitors may work in their Horse/pony prior to a class or phase

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, times or any other published information. In the event of cancellation all fees will be refunded less 15%

Unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency callout
